
Reduce air infiltration


Dealing with exterior mold & mildew

A blanket for your house:

Energy-efficient, insulated siding

With a growing emphasis on ecoconscious living, homeowners recognize the importance and value of having an energy efficient home.

"Today's homeowners are looking for ways to improve their home's energy performance," says Jery Y. "A common problem with homes today is the thermal bridging effect, which can rob a home of heat and waste energy and money."

In thermal bridging, the studs act as a passageway for heat to escape. Most insulation helps seal wall cavities, but the wall studs on either side of the cavities are often left exposed, reducing the insulating value of the entire wall.

"Continuous wall insulation is crucial to



fully seal the exterior and protect against heat loss," says Jerry Blais, vice president of marketing for Ply Gem, a leading manufacturer of home remodeling and building products.
"Insulated siding is one solution that helps reduce the impact of thermal bridging, add-

ing a blanket of insulation over the exposed wall studs."

Tips for a great lawn this fall

The approach of fall means different things in different parts of the country. Seed:

Leaves that have been left on the lawn and chopped up into dime sized pieces by the mower provide a natural layer of organic matter that will break down and help nourish the lawn. Once the leaf bits settle in, microbes and worms get to work recycling them. Any kind of rotary-action mower will do the job chopping up any kind of leaf. With several passes of your mower, you can mulch up to 18 inches of leaf clutter.

Feed:

Grass needs nutrients just like you do. With the proper feeding, grass will grow stronger, deeper roots that can endure harsh conditions and crowd out weeds. 
Protect your deck this winter

A guide for getting through emergency home repairs

From water and drainage systems to electrical and heating/cooling configurations, your home is a complex network of pipes, wires and electrical components that could require an emergency repair at any time.

An outside water pipe breaking or a sewer line collapsing can easily rank as a homeowners' worst nightmare; however, when an emergency occurs, most homeowners are not aware of who is responsible for the damage. In fact, less than 50 percent of the homeowners in a recent national survey, conducted by GfK Roper Custom Research, knew that they were responsible for repairs to the water line between their house and the street.

This is where companies that offer emergency home repair plans, such as HomeServe USA, can make the difference between peace of mind and an expensive and time-consuming repair.

"According the results of the survey, one third of all homeowners responding assumed



that their local utility was responsible for the cost of a burst water line between their house and the street, when this is usually not the case," says Tom Rusin, chief executive officer of HomeServe USA. "One of the challenges of home ownership is that the potential for expensive repairs is always out there. In fact, repairing a water service line can cost more than \$2,000 and simply clearing a blocked drain can cost upwards of \$350."

Rusin suggests that all homeowners do the following things to minimize the potential financial liability and hassle associated with home repair emergencies:

- 1. Speak to your homeowners insurance agent to get a clear understanding of which areas of your home are covered by your insurance policy and which ones are not. Potential trouble spots include interior and exterior electrical wiring, outside water service and sewer lines, inside plumbing and gas piping, central heating and air conditioning systems, and the water heater.
- 2. Similarly, speak to your local electric, gas, and water utilities to determine equipment that you may be responsible for.
- 3. Proper maintenance of home components greatly minimizes the chance of an unexpected emergency. For example, check the air filter on your central heating or cooling system regularly and change it about once every three months during the season. Protect water pipes from freezing with proper insulation or draining them prior to winter. And fix leaky faucets and toilets to save water and prevent bigger problems.
- 4. Consider a home emergency protection plan that can relieve you of not only the financial burden of a home emergency, but also the uncertainty involved in looking for a repair person on a Sunday afternoon. (ARA)

De-stressing design decisions

Here are a handful of common design decision headaches and a few ideas for curing them:

■ Too many options

Walking into a big box store or a design showroom can leave you feeling overwhelmed by the sheer volume of choices you face. Before you confront a dizzying array of options, narrow your choices by deciding what style you like. Settling on an overall style that will be carried throughout your design can help you eliminate design options right off the bat.

For example, if a traditional, country style appeals to you, you'll know you don't even have to look at stainless steel countertops or frosted-glass-front cabinets. Look to online resources like BHG.com (the Better Homes and Gardens home page) or HGTV.com for ideas about design styles you may like.



■ High-pressure sales tactics

Buying design elements at a specialty store has advantages and disadvantages. On one hand, you're more likely to find a knowledgeable salesperson. On the other, you may face high-pressure sales tactics - something no one responds well to. The strong sell makes it difficult to know if you're getting good advice or a decent deal. Shopping online at specialty sites like Blinds.com is a great solution.

You can find plenty of advice and highquality options, minus the pressure of dealing face-to-face with a pushy salesperson in your home. If you do need to talk to a person, you'll get someone who specializes in what you're buying, rather than buying blinds from someone who works in the cosmetics department.

Clueless customer service

And that cosmetics department transplant is a perfect example of another major design decision stress-causer: clueless customer service. Sometimes you need guidance. And sometimes you need to talk to someone who knows enough about what you're buying to be able to interpret your description of what you're looking for when you don't really know what it's called.
